Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to **39 tonnes tCO2e by August 2028**. This is a reduction of 30%.

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Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 1.7 tCO2e, a 3% reduction against the 2023 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

Over the last 12 months these include:

- The introduction of a company-wide 'bike to work' scheme to encourage a reduction of car-based commuting.
- An increase in the use of working from home strategies.
- Conversion of company car fleet to electric.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Introduce
- More localised recruitment to support reduced travel times
- Further use of working from home strategies
- Update our supply chain to encourage the use of carbon neutral providers for delivery, uniforms and technology supplies in particular
- Work towards a 100% digital / paperless office environment
- Requiring office staff / agency staff only to travel by public transport
